Guidelines for Poster Exhibition

1 General Information

- The poster presented at the symposium must cover the same topic as the accepted abstract.
- Please carefully proofread your poster for any grammatical or spelling mistakes and check for consistent use of terminology.
- Abbreviations may be used after the full term was first introduced e.g. sinus floor elevation (SFE)
- You certify that animal or clinical studies have been reviewed and approved by the responsible local authorities and/or Institutional Review Board to assure compliance with ethical guidelines.
 Any human experimentation must conform to the principles of the Declaration of Helsinki of the World Medical Association.
- Basic or clinical research posters may include the following primary investigating topics:
 - Periodontal regeneration
 - Soft tissue regeneration
 - Hard tissue regeneration
 - Maxillo-facial regeneration
 - Complication management
 - Regeneration materials
 - Cell therapy
 - Growth factors
 - Biological mechanisms
 - o Systemic diseases
 - Implant placement




2 Structure of the Poster

All abstracts shall be structured as follows:

- Title of the study
 - Do not write the title in CAPITAL letters
 - o Limit the title to a maximum of 200 characters (incl. spaces).
 - o The title should indicate the content of the abstract in a concise manner.
- Author list
 - The presenting author should be marked with an asterisk*
 - "First Name Last Name" of the author and co-authors (a maximum of six names –
 first author & five co-authors is allowed). Do not write in CAPITAL letters.
 - Do not write titles such as Dr., Prof., PhD before or after names.
- Institutional affiliations of all authors
- Objectives
- Material & Methods
- Results & Discussion
- Conclusion

3 Poster Format

- The poster dimension should not exceed 90 cm in width and 130 cm in height.
- Please use portrait format only (landscape format is not allowed)!
- The suggested size is A0 (ISO 216 sizes, specifies international standard (ISO) paper sizes width and height: 84.1 cm × 118.9 cm).
- Illustrations and text must be readable from distances of at least 1.5 meters. All lettering on the poster should be a minimum of 1 cm in height (at least 2 cm for the title).

4 Poster PDF Upload & Audience Award

- Upload your poster PDF to the Osteology community platform THE BOX by 20 April 2023.
 - Login > "My Research" > "Osteology Poster Exhibition" >> link to upload the PDF file.
- All posters uploaded on The BOX compete for two Audience Awards, one for preclinical and one
 for clinical research each worth € 500. Award winners are picked by most "likes" for their poster
 from The BOX community. Participants are encouraged to vote online during the symposium.

5 Mounting of Posters

- Posters can be mounted after symposium registration, from Wednesday, 26 April 2023, 16.00 onwards
- You received a poster number for the symposium in a separate e-mail.
- Poster authors will find their poster number on the empty poster board for mounting the poster.
- To attach your poster to the poster board, please only use the material provided in the poster exhibition area or ask at the registration desk for the material.
- Please only use the provided double-sided Tesa Powerstrips (max. 4 stripes/poster).

6 Poster Exhibition

- The Research Poster Exhibition will be open on Friday and Saturday during the symposium. To
 enhance the scientific exchange, all poster authors are asked to be available during coffee and
 lunch breaks.
- Presence times at the posters are as follows: Friday, 28 April 2023 from 12.55 to 14.15 and on Saturday, 29 April 2023 from 13.30 to 14.30.

If the designated presenter is unable to attend, they must notify the Osteology Office (grants@osteology.org) by e-mail prior to the International Osteology Symposium Barcelona to withdraw the abstract OR name a substitute presenter. The new presenter should be marked with an asterisk* on the author list.



7 Research Networking Day - Poster Dismantling

Authors invited to the Research Networking Day must transfer their poster from the Research Networking Day room to the General poster exhibition hall immediately after the end of the Research Networking Day (Thursday, 27 April 2023 between 17.15 - 18.00). One poster printout for the whole Symposium is therefore sufficient.
